Randy Spivey, CEO The Center for Protection & Safety was presented to an intimate group of members and provided high level wisdom in return.

On April 6, 18 members attended the general meeting. Randy Spivey, CEO of The Center for Protection & Safety along with management member Dave Benson presented on the topic of active shooter and what to do when shots are fired.

Mr. Spivey made opening remarks and then played a 16-minute video that they produced called "Shots Fired, When Lightning Strikes." Here are some of the points that were provided:

- Having no plan almost always guarantees the wrong response.
- OSHA says that you need to have a safe workplace. The "active shooter" incident is a foreseeable risk.
- People also need to be trained on how to behave or respond when the Emergency Responders arrive. Everyone needs to remember and be thinking that the emergency responders do not know who is good and who is not. It is important to let them see your hands with your fingers spread. This helps them to quickly see that you are not a threat.
