“Mentoring Security Leaders” Program



ASIS International (ASIS) is introducing the Mentoring Security Leaders program. This new program, developed by the ASIS Leadership Management Practices Council (LMPC) as a resource for ASIS chapters and members, is designed to promote long term leadership and career development through a one-on-one mentor-protégé relationship. It was developed and successfully piloted by six ASIS chapters over the course of two years.

The Mentoring Security Leaders program employs a career development methodology whereby ASIS members (protégés) are matched with experienced ASIS colleagues (mentors) for guidance and professional advice.

The mentors are asked to share their experiences and advice on career advancement, professional visibility, networking, and overcoming barriers to career success. The protégé will gain knowledge and experience in meeting immediate business-level requirements. This program is for members at all levels in their careers who may want some specialized insights into a particular skill, competency, change in industry sector, or even a transition to a different role in the industry.
