With more than 600 athletes anticipated to compete in Philadelphia, volunteers are needed to assist with sporting events from archery to weightlifting, as well as to serve as greeters at the airport, hospitality messengers, meal assistants, and much more. The volunteer opportunities are many, and the experience will last a lifetime.

It is inspirational to see the athletes participate in 19 competitive and exhibition sporting events. When you can hear the crowds cheering on athletes at a swimming competition or see an athlete make that final shot with seconds to go in a basketball game, there is no doubt that you will get goose bumps.
